Total \$26,000 will be awarded

Members of the Future Fund met on October 17, at the San Angelo Country Club to discuss recent grant requests made to SAAF for 2017. After discussion of survey results and grant requests, the consensus was to award \$10,000 to Meals for the Elderly, \$6,500 to Junior League of San Angelo, \$5,000 to West Texas Counseling & Guidance Center, and \$4,500 to Boys & Girls Club of San Angelo.

2017 Grant Highlights:

\$10,000 Meals for the Elderly- Is in need of both a website upgrade and upgrade of a security system for the building. Desire to better utilize the current technology available to help with the high abandonment rate currently experienced because of website redirects during the donation process. The services and meals provided tends to attract some of the transient population, creating staff safety issues and increased vandalism and theft, thus the need for enhanced security. **Future Fund was able to fully fund request!**

\$6,500 Junior League of San Angelo - Junior League of San Angelo in collaboration with the Tom Green County Young Lawyers Association is seeking funds to provide the supplies for the Done in a Day project "Hope Totes". These bags will provide basic comforts for children that have been removed from their home due to safety concerns. Often they do not have the opportunity to gather any belongings. The kits would be readily available to investigators and caseworkers to distribute as needed. **Future Fund was able to fully fund request!**

\$5,000 West Texas Counseling & Guidance- Professional counseling demand has continued to rise for the last 5 years. WTCG has adapted to meet the needs of the Concho valley each year without creating a wait list or turning away clients who do not have insurance or the ability to pay copays or full fees. WTCG strives to provide the needed counseling to anyone regardless of income or insurance status. To keep up with the estimated demand WTCG has applied for the funding to offset the cost of providing services for clients in lower socioeconomic status and those without health insurance or under insured. **Grant funding from Future Fund combined with other funds of the Foundation total \$18,000 fully funding their request!**

\$4,500 Boys & Girls Club of San Angelo-Boys and Girls Club San Angelo is looking to implement new programming "Be Great: Graduate" a comprehensive targeted dropout prevention intervention designed to enhance engagement with learning by providing consistent support from caring trusted adults. The program is based on mentoring students ages 6-18 to drive academic success. **Grant funding from Future Fund combined with other funds of the Foundation total \$12,500 to organization!**

2017 is the 8th year that Future Fund has awarded grants to local non-profit organizations. We are truly thankful for your participation and look forward to the growth of FUTURE FUND!

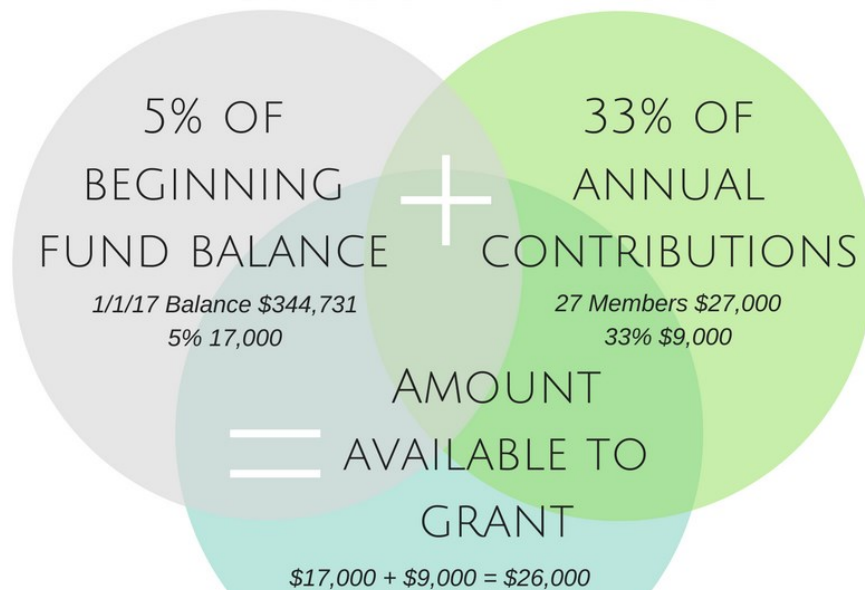
