Through the competitive grant making program of the Foundation, the following organizations in the Concho Valley received a grant during the spring grant to deliver impactful services to our communities. Generous donors have entrusted the Foundation to manage their donor advised funds, discretionary and field of interest funds as well as unrestricted funds giving to the Foundation to make the following grants possible.

- **Alcohol & Drug Awareness Center for the Concho Valley \$50,000** - Help with updating facility flooring
- **YMCA \$10,000** - Support with expansion of classroom capacity for Little Explorers program
- **Eldorado Service Center \$30,000** - Assist with access to hygiene and cleaning products for low income households in Schleicher County
