- A committee of six like-minded volunteers
 - May 2023
 - Explored feasibility of privately funded PAC
 - Unanimous support of CISD school board
 - Build site donated and approved
 - MOU developed and signed
- Vision, Mission statements developed
- Contract signed with San Angelo Area Foundation
- Website developed
- Site visits to area and regional PACs
- Architect interviews and selection
- Seed money donations pursued past 12 months
- Soft Launch following encore OAP performance May 2024

SAN ANGELO Area Foundation

- Contract signed with San Angelo Area Foundation as Special Project
- Obtained 501C3 status for tax deductible donations
- Project created to raise funds and leverage partnerships between private funding and foundational grants
- *OUR VISION*: To create a facility to adequately support and present any and all school functions including the performing arts department of CISD.

WHY NOW?

- No secret that CISD has many needs
 - Classroom space
 - Updating current buildings
 - Free standing middle school
- We are *NOT* a mineral rich county
 - Upton, Irion counties
 - Billion dollar bases
 - School Finance Laws
- 25 years since last school bond passed
 - Student population tripled
 - Building space remained the same



Why now? (continued)


As a result, *Extracurricular facilities* like a performing arts center are *not a priority*, nor can extracurricular facilities ever be!

Current situation:

- Band hall small and inefficient to meet needs
 - For instrument storage
 - For practice space for any band of competing size
 - Not conducive to growing band size
 - Not conducive to band pride



- One Act Play performers and cast use a stage in the high school cafeteria
 - NOT UIL compliant
 - Must resize set layout when performing on UIL compliant stage
 - Places handicap on our OAP cast and crew
 - Christoval HS OAP public performances occur in a rented facility in San Angelo (SAPAC)

DID YOU KNOW?

- **43**% of the students in grades **6-12** at CISD are enrolled in the performing arts.
- That is more students than any other extracurricular activity at CISD
- Students in the arts are more likely to earn exceptional scores on standardized testing
- **20%** of students in the arts are more likely to attend college, with 42% more likely to attend a 4 year college or university (Texas Cultural Trust publication 2023)

The Arts prepare for 21st century workforce

- Develops core competency and interpersonal skills
 - Creativity,
 - Innovation,
 - Critical thinking,
 - Problem solving,
 - Communication and
 - Collaboration skills

 The Arts generated 6 billion dollars in past decade for Texas economy
 Nearly ONE in 15 Texas jobs are creative careers (*Texas Cultural Trust publication 2023*)

How Much is Needed?

- Large capital project
 - Researched other rural and urban schools
 - Identified best practices for completion
 - Contract signed with Jacob-Martin Architects
 - Establishing probable costs
 - Initial architectural renderings and floor plan done
 - Continue to refine architectural plans
 - Initial target estimate of 12 to 15 million dollars
 - Approximately 30,000 square foot building





Will be multifunctional building

- CISD functions:
 - Awards programs,
 - UIL competitions,
 - Recitals,
 - Summer programs,
 - Band concerts,
 - OAP performances, and
 - Prom
- Community functions:
 - board meetings,
 - social functions
 - Texas En Plein Air displays and awards ceremonies
- Can have year-round revenue generating events for CISD, unlike seasonal events
- Future generated events can include choir, orchestra, or dance

- No contribution is too small
 - Ongoing need for seed money
 - Printings, mailings, architectural meeting costs
- No contribution is too large
 - Can fund the whole project if you desire
 - 3 donors contributed the first 1.5 million to the SAPAC project
- Will have naming rights for particular areas of the project
 - Auditorium
 - Lobby
 - Performing Arts Center Building
 - Meeting Rooms...

• WE need your influence and help!

• TIMELINE

- Private donors (June 2024-December 2025)
- Foundation donors (January-December 2025)
- Final architectural plans (January-May 2026)
- Construction bids (July -December 2026)
- Construction (January 2027-May 2028)
- Events begin (May 2028)
- Have 4 years remaining on our SAAF contract, then funds are rolled into a SAAF endowment fund for CISD performing arts program
