CONCHO VALLEY REGIONAL FOOD BANK

Helping to end hunger in the Concho Valley, the Food2Kids program provides support to children that have been identified as having food insecurities over the weekend when they do not have access to the school lunches and breakfasts. The weekend SNACKPACK program means that children will not show up to school on a Monday desperate for a meal. On average, 1,200 bags are provided to kids across the Concho Valley each week and are made available to households in transition or facing a crisis. **Grant funding from Future Fund fully funded this request.**

DISASTER RELIEF FUND

Flooding on July 4, 2025 affected over 1,800 verified locations in the Concho Valley, with more than 800 homes receiving significant damage. The San Angelo Area Foundation, along with members of the COAD (Community Organizations Active in Disaster) have been helping residents who have been impacted through emergency grants from the Disaster Relief Fund to assist with pressing needs and immediate repairs to homes. As our community moves from response to recovery, a Long Term Recovery Group (LTRG) has been established www.conchovalleytogether.org to ensure a collaborative response continues to address unmet needs and/or challenges our residents are facing. This collaborative partnership is committed to ensuring that no one faces this disaster alone. As our community begins to rebuild, the LTRG is committed to working alongside residents offering support and providing assistance for repairs. Long Term Recovery Grants will continue to be distributed over the coming months/year. **Future Fund granted \$20,000 to assist our neighbors in need.**

SUR, INC.

SUR, Inc., is organized for the specific purpose of holding title to buildings to be used solely by local Alcoholics Anonymous and Al-Anon groups. SUR owns a building at 1917 W. Ave N. and it has been rented to the Sherwood AA Group since 1987. The need for a security system monitoring the two entrances has been identified. This will provide keyless entry so that unauthorized persons do not gain access to the building. A keyless, secure solution is needed so only authorized individuals can access the building. **A grant from Future Fund fully funded the request.**
